**Activities 1st -2nd Grade**

1. Make a picture timeline of all the events in the book.
2. Draw a picture of your favorite page. If possible, explain in writing why this page is your favorite.
3. Draw a portrait of the main character and write a one-sentence summary to accompany your sketch. Draw a picture postcard to a friend about what the book is about.

**Activities 3rd- 5th Grade**

1. PowerPoint addressing different story elements including character, setting, plot, problem and solution. Students must also provide information on the author and the author's purpose.
2. Write a character diary, writing at least four journal entries as if you are the main character in the story. Write down events that happen during the story and reflect on how they affected the character and why.
3. Create a timeline of the major events in your book. Label each event.
